Principal's Report (Mr. Fred Louws):

- Sports Girls' Volleyball tryouts, Boys' Basketball, Football (Sr. Boys' team lost to A.N. Myer last week). The coaches are aiming to keep practicing through the winter in order to prep for the spring football league. These practices will take place after school in the gym as long as it doesn't interfere with the winter sports.
- Brock Caribou Math Contest November 23rd (Ms. Tonin teacher rep). There were approximately 15-20 students from GFESS participating. More students are encouraged to participate. Universities take note for those who do well in the contest, but do not penalize those who don't do as well.
